 2. xxx: One of any 3 unit Acupuncture elective courses is required for the degree. At least one of the acupuncture elective courses is offered every quarter.
 3. *: Series courses do not need to be taken in a sequence.
 4. **: CPR certificate is required for all students before he/she starts internships, takes the California Acupuncture Board Exam and NCCAOM exams.
 5. ***: A "pass" grade for the **Pre-Clinical Exam** is required for students to begin their clinical internship; Students must pass all Clinic Phase Exams before he/she is allowed to take the Comprehensive Exam; A "pass" grade for the **Comprehensive Exam** is required for graduation with the Master degree.
 6. "Elective" courses will be opened upon students' petitions.
